Resettlement Action Plan (RAP)

Mano River Union Road Development and Transport Facilitation Programme Phase III: (Paving of Kelipo to John Davies Town (61.5 km))

The Ministry of Public Works (MPW), on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Liberia, has secured financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) for the implementation of Phase III of the Mano River Union Road Development and Transport Facilitation Programme (MRU/RDTFP) [Paving of Kelipo to John Davis Town (61.5km)] .

Phase III involves the rehabilitation and paving of the Kelipo to John Davies Town road corridor (61.5 km) located in River Gee and Grand Gedeh Counties. The project forms part of a regional initiative aimed at strengthening transport connectivity, facilitating trade, and improving access to markets and essential services for corridor communities.

In compliance with the African Development Bank Integrated Safeguards System (ISS), specifically Operational Safeguard 2 (OS 2) on Involuntary Resettlement – Land Acquisition, Population Displacement and Compensation, and the Environmental Protection and Management Law (EPML, 2003) of Liberia, the Ministry hereby informs the public that the Resettlement Action Plan (RAP) for the project has been finalized and is available for disclosure.

The RAP identifies affected persons and assets, defines eligibility and compensation measures, provides for livelihood restoration where required, and establishes a Grievance Redress Mechanism to address concerns arising from project implementation. Compensation and resettlement assistance will be implemented in accordance with AfDB safeguard requirements and applicable national legislation prior to commencement of civil works in affected areas.
